

3/18/18 Pulling Up a Seat at Our Savior's Table Jesus at Table with a Prominent Pharisee Luke 14:15-24

Point to Ponder: In Revelation 19 the angel spoke to John saying: "Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!" (Rev. 19:9b) The great banquet is still in the future but the invitation comes to us in the present. "Come, for everything is now ready," said the servant in Jesus parable. What will be our answer, as we hear in the call of gospel? What will keep us from coming to the table? If we are so foolish as to refuse this great invitation - no matter what excuse we might make - it is not just dinner that we will miss, but our very salvation.
