The Good News of Jesus Our Response? Mark 1:1-20

Question: How should we respond to good news?

- I. The Beginning of the Gospel Good News (1:1)
 - ~ concerning Jesus Christ, the Son of God
- II. The Way Prepared for the Christ the Long-Awaited Messiah (2-8)
- III. The Announcement of the Beloved and Pleasing Son of God (9-13)
- IV. The Message of Jesus Good News! (14-15a)
- V. The Fitting Response to Good News (15b-20)
 - A. Repent and believe the good news
 - B. Drop everything and follow Him

Point to Ponder: If you have worshiped with us before, there is no doubt that your ears have heard good news concerning Jesus. The question is: what has been your response? If you had to describe your response - what would you say? To what degree have you repented from your sin, believed the good news and dropped everything and followed Him?
