Question: What does God want from me?

I. Witnesses Assembled: The Mountains (6:1-2)

~ for they were there when God acted for his people

II. A Defense of God's Actions Provided (6:3-5)

~ Remember what I have done for you!

III. A Defense of Israel's Actions (6:6-7)

~What in the world do you want from us?

- IV. What the Lord Requires He Has Shown You (6:8)
 - A. Act Justly
 - B. Love Mercy (loving kindness hesed)
 - C. Walk Humbly before your God

Point to Ponder: "When I survey the wondrous cross, on which the Prince of glory died, My richest gain I count but loss, And pour contempt on all my pride..."

"Were the whole realm of nature mine, That were a present far too small; Love so amazing so divine, Demands my life, my soul, my all." With what should we come before God? Begrudging, half-hearted, going-through-the-motions worship? No, if we are His, and if we know and remember what He has done for us, then we will present Him with our lives. Have you given Him your life?
