Opening Eyes to See the Cross: A Ransom for Many Mark 10:32-45

The Question: Why did Jesus die?

- I. Walking to the Cross (32-34)
- II. Misguided Implications of the Cross (35-41)
- III. The Way of the Cross (42-44)
- IV. The Why of the Cross (45)

Point to Ponder: If all we hear in the cross is a call to servanthood, we will have missed the cross. Jesus did not come to die merely as a powerful example of servanthood. He came to "give his life as a ransom for many." The question remains: has he ransomed you?

A Note to Parents: Please know that the children and youth who leave the service during the sermon are looking at the same passage we will consider each week. We hope that you will initiate a conversation with them about this portion of God's Word.
