Question: What does God desire from us as we interact with his Word?

I. The Book of the Law Found and the King's Response (1-13)

Note in vs. 11 & 13 these words:

- ~ "heard the words of the Book of the Law"
- ~ "he **tore** his clothes"
- ~ "inquire of the LORD for me"

II. God's Take on the King's Response (14-20)


Note in vs. 19 these words:

- ~ "your heart was **penitent** (NIV- **responsive** / NASB **tender**)
- ~ "you **humbled** yourself before the LORD"
- ~ "you have **torn** your clothes and wept"

Point to Ponder: We can't always change our own heart, but how might we set the table for a heart change towards God's Word?
