## The Way We Could Be Using Abundance with Thoughtfulness James 5:1-6 (Page 1201)

Question: Why Should We Not Envy or Emulate the Self-Centered Rich?

- I. Hoarding that Testifies before the Lord (vs. 2-3)
- II. Extravagance Towards Self which Readies for Judgment (vs. 5)
- III. Injustice Toward Others which is Seen by the Lord (vs. 4 & 6)

It makes no sense to envy or emulate those headed for judgment!

**Points to Ponder:** Read and ponder Philippians 4:11-12. Then pray that our Lord might grant us (you, me, the people of this fellowship) the contentment described by the Apostle Paul.
