If an outsider observer did an investigation into your use of time, energy, and money, what would they conclude you value most in life?

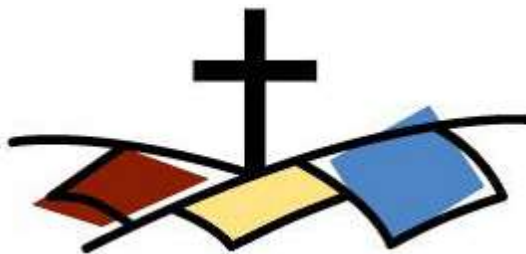
