Question: Where can we find security in an insecure world?

- I. A Cry for Security (vs.1)
- II. A Confession of Trust in the LORD (2-4)
- III. A Contentment in the Provision of the LORD (5-8)
- IV. A Confidence of Security found in the LORD (9-11)

Point to Ponder:

Question 1 What is your only comfort, in life and in death?

Answer: That I belong - body and soul, in life and in death - not to myself but to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ, who at the cost of his own blood has fully paid for all my sins and has completely freed me from the dominion of the devil; that he protects me so well that without the will of my Father in heaven not a hair can fall from my head; indeed, that everything must fit his purpose for my salvation. Therefore, by his Holy Spirit, he also assures me of eternal life, and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready form now on to live for him.

(The first question and answer from the Heidelberg Catechism)
