Truly Amazing Amazed at His Doing All Things Well Mark 7:31-37


Question: Which amazes you more: a freak show, or a thing of unparalleled significance (something of cosmic proportions and eternal implications)?

- **I. The Occasion**: Deaf Man with a Speech Impediment Brought to Jesus (31-32)
- **II. The Healing**: Communication without Words (33-35)
- III. The Reaction: (36-37)
 - ~ Couldn't Keep Quiet
 - ~ Astonished Beyond Measure
 - ~ "He Does All Things Well"
 - ~ Even the Deaf Hear and the Mute Speak

Point to Ponder: Those who saw Jesus couldn't keep it quiet - the good news was too good not to share. If that is a sign of amazement - how amazed are we with Jesus?
