~ "He Does All Things Well"

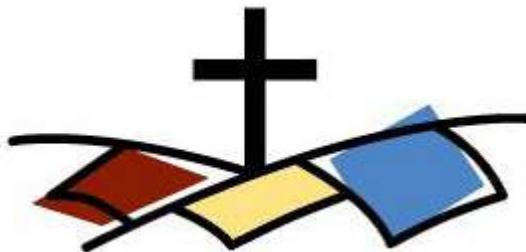
